With funding from the European Union, CARE International and its Palestinian partners are implementing Bena'a project "Empowering Palestinian Women–Transforming Communities". Bena'a is a 36 month project, starting in January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2010.

The objective of the "Bena'a" project is to build the capacity of grassroots CBOs in order to ensure those women's voices and interests are heard and incorporated in development strategies and in social, political, and economic decision-making processes locally and nationally.

The "Bena'a" project is implemented in partnership with the Women Affairs Technical Committee (WATC) and the Women Affairs Centre (WAC), who are supporting ten CBOs working throughout the Gaza Strip.

On the occasion of International Women's Day, this poster has come as a tool of targeting people to highlight the role of woman in the development process and emphasize the rights of women to a life with dignity.

1000 copies of this poster were distributed among the partners CBO's and their communities. More visibility and publications will be distributed throughout the life of the project from the July 1, 2009 launch-date of the Bena'a Project's campaign Combating Violence against Women and Children.
