

“Quick Impact Agricultural Livelihood Recovery”

- **Beneficiaries**

Conflict-Affected Beneficiaries (average of 8 persons per households)	
Small-Scale Farmers	1,230 farmers/ 9,840 individuals
Rural Households	300 households/ 2400 individuals
Deep Poor Households	2,000 households/ 16,000 individuals

- **Location**

Northern Gaza Strip; Middle Area; Eastern Buffer Zone Communities; Across Gaza Strip (Food Distributions).

- **Objective and Results**

- Support for 1,000 small-scale farmers for livelihood recovery including rehabilitation of agricultural production (minimum 400EUR/year).
- Support to 230 small-scale farmers to access market and increase income and to 2,000 food insecure households to access nutritious food.
- Support for 300 rural households to rehabilitate and repair agricultural infrastructure in at least 4 marginalised communities.

- **Donor** - Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA)

- **Funding** - 3.2 Million CAD

- **Time-frame** - July 17, 2009 to April 30, 2011
