- **Location**

West Bank: *Health* (Jenin, Tubas, Hebron and East Bethlehem), *Water* (Jenin, Tulkarem, Nablus)

Gaza Strip: North Gaza, Middle Area, and South District

- **Objective and Results**

- At least 62 health facilities are operational to meet quality primary health care needs of individuals in the West Bank and Gaza.
- At least 3,189 households in the West Bank and Gaza have better and improved access to water.

¹ The estimate of 8 as the average family size is based on CARE’s experience of implementing the Fresh Food and Food Security programs in Gazan rural villages, and in particular low/no income rural households that have a higher average household size

- At least 16,000 individuals in West Bank and Gaza have access to health, hygiene and water management information that allows them to protect and promote their own health and well-being.
- **Donor** - European Department for Humanitarian Assistance (ECHO)
- **Funding** - 1.9 Million EUR
- **Time-frame** – *March 1, 2009 – February 28, 2010*
