- **Location**

East Gaza City neighbourhoods of Shejaiya, Shaath, Tuffah, Zeitoun and Darraj as well as Beit Hanoun, Beit Lahia areas

- **Objective and Results**

- High quality child-centered conflict mitigation program is established and owned by the local community in Gaza.
- Three Gaza CSO partners are equipped with skills and tools to implement high quality conflict mitigation activities.
- Three partner CBOs working together and forming a network to coordinate activities, exchange experience and lessons learned in the areas they serve.
- At least 2400 children from “at-risk” group actively participate and benefit from conflict mitigation activities.
- At least 48 university students/graduates (male and female) trained in intentional programming techniques and methodologies to deliver a curriculum promoting conflict mitigation.
- At least 500 parents of children participating in the program actively engaged with the Eye to the Future facilities and program through regular meetings, events, and training.
- At least 60 community leaders and decision-makers in the target communities benefit from participating with the Eye to the Future program
